HOW DO I FIND A PARTICIPATING CLUB TO VISIT?

Search online at healthclubs.com/passport, the area of IHRSA's consumer web site that includes only IHRSA clubs that participate in the IHRSA Passport Program.

Note: An airplane symbol  on a club's listing indicates their participation in the IHRSA Passport Program.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING TO THE CLUB I'M VISITING?

You are required to show a valid form of Passport I.D., obtained from your home club. Most clubs will ask for a valid form of photo identification as well.

WILL I PAY A GUEST FEE TO USE OTHER PASSPORT CLUBS?

Usually. Participating clubs have committed to discounting their regular guest fee by at least 50%, though some clubs will waive guest fees entirely. It is important to always call the club in advance to verify any guest fees that may apply as well as to confirm the availability of the facilities you intend to use.

CAN I USE THE IHRSA PASSPORT PROGRAM INTERNATIONALLY?

Absolutely! More than 1,700 clubs in over 50 countries participate in the IHRSA Passport Program, making it a great benefit if you're traveling abroad!

CAN I USE THE IHRSA PASSPORT PROGRAM FOR AN EXTENDED STAY AT ONE CLUB?

No. The IHRSA Passport Program is intended for short-term use only. Consult the club for any restrictions that may apply.

CAN I USE OTHER CLUBS NEAR MY HOME CLUB THROUGH THE IHRSA PASSPORT PROGRAM?

Clubs must be located at least 50 miles/80 kilometers away from your home club.

IF I RELOCATE, CAN I TRANSFER MY MEMBERSHIP TO ANOTHER PASSPORT CLUB?

No. The IHRSA Passport Program is only intended to provide guest privileges at participating clubs.
